Hello,

Thank you for your interest in learning Archery. Our next Archery Beginners' course will run for five consecutive Sunday sessions on **4th, 11th, 18th, 25th July, and 1st August 2021**. The first four sessions will be instruction and the final session will be a Fun Shoot with prizes and members of the club will be shooting with you. Please note you must complete a minimum of 4 sessions to be eligible for a certificate which will enable you to join an archery club.

The course will be held at St Martins School, Ranmore Road, Dorking, RH4 1HW. Each session will be 90 minutes starting at 12:00 noon. It would however be helpful if you could arrive at 11.45a.m. as it does take some time to sort and put equipment together. Our minimum age for participants is 10 years old. There is no maximum age limit

These five sessions will give you the basic information on equipment, rules and technique. The whole course fee, which includes hire of all equipment and insurance, is £40 with a 10% discount on family bookings of two or more

Wear comfortable clothing that is not too loose and also solid footwear. No flip-flops! Also please tie long hair back. We will shoot if it is wet – providing it's not a monsoon – so do come prepared.

If you are aged between 10 and 18 you must be accompanied by a parent (or other person over the age of 18). In this event, why not try to persuade your parent or accompanying adult to have a go? Archery is, after all, a sport which the whole family can enjoy.
